MINUTES FOR APRIL 19, 2007

Meeting was called to order by George Romans, Vice. Pres at 7:20.

Minutes were read for March 15, 2007. Minutes were not approved by membership with a vote to amend. Motion to amend and seconded.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- 1) First Citizen report by Nancy. Doors to open 6:00 April 21<sup>st</sup> starting with a buffet and entertainment. Celebration to start at 7:00 pm. The News Review will be here to advertise the winner. Nancy asked for help with the buffet. The selection for First Citizen was made by previous winners for nominees that were considered.
- 2) Bingo will still be on going on Friday night except for the Friday before the Wild Flower Show.
- 3) The roof - Grant committee by Bill Scheufele. This will start after the wild flower show and when weather permits. \$9,635.80 has been allocated plus \$500.00 for shipping. Material will be delivered and stored out back. This will be snaplock metal roofing. It was determined that part of the Annex building will be hot tarred. No other grants other than for the roof per Bill Scheufele. Things are on hold.
- 4) Scholarship committee. Patricia Gilhart, Christy Scheufele and Nancy Teague. This is connected to the Wild Flower Show and they need cakes, pies and muffins. They need volunteers for food serving Saturday and Sunday. Monies earned go to the Scholarship Fund.
- 5) \$350.00 approved for the popcorn machine that Susan Flury purchased for \$500.00. Do we want to approve the balance of \$150.00? Bill Scheufele argued that it should go before the membership. Patricia Gilhart suggested we should research when the \$350.00 was approved. This will be tabled till next meeting.
- 6) Donnabelle Jones reported that we cleared \$298.00 for the talent show and spaghetti dinner.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1) Senior co-ordinator Jeanne Wright addressed complaints that have been made. Would like all complaints or problems to see her personally.
- 2) Wild Flower Show. Addressed storage problem. Agree to make more storage possible by buying plastic tubs for stacking supplies for more room. Space should be shared by Glide Community Club and Wild Flower Show.
- 3) Storage for Wild River's Tang Soo Do on the inside back wall in locked box.

- 5) Taxes were discussed and tabled for next meeting.
- 6) Membership dues were addressed. Rates were discussed by Dom, George and Jim and were tabled for more discussion.
- 7) Discussion on by law changes was tabled.
- 8) Question was - Can we build on to the annex building for more storage? Idea was presented by Bill Scheufele.
