Unfinished Business

Linda Tipton inquired as to whether Gary was hired as a Handyman or a contractor and wondered why we'd replaced it. Bob explained that he felt the door had been installed incorrectly. Susan's opinion was that we let it go and move on. Bill Scheufele thought Gary should return the money. Donnabelle stated that there was a lot of bad press in the community over the door issue. Bill S. then moved that we leave the issue as is and move on without asking for any refund from Gary. Donnabelle seconded the motion which passed by majority.

Planning Commission/Building Dept. The paperwork to move the boundary between GCC and Lauren Young's property has been filled out and the fee of \$102.00 has been paid. The next step is to get the Young's signature on the application.

There was no report on the bylaws as Nan Smith was unable to attend.

Accounting System: Lois is looking into using another accounting system or refining what we have. She will pursue this. Tom Tipton moved that we authorize Lois to spend up to \$100.00 if necessary. Linda Tipton seconded and the motion passed by majority.

Bob also expressed concern about problems with the furnace stack. Susan will call Roseburg Refrigeration and have the furnace and stack inspected.

Craft Bazaar/Fire Dept. Barbecue: Debbie Dean will not be organizing the Barbecue this year and it was decided that we may still have the craft bazaar. There will be more discussion on this.

New Business

Carol Henry moved that we give Donnabelle and her committee \$40.00 for the event. Patricia Gilbert seconded the motion which passed by majority.
