**Paving Project:** Jim Smith asked for directions from the Board about the next step regarding the paving project. He had a complete proposal for the project(s) from Knife River. There was considerable discussion regarding this matter; we currently have enough monies to complete one portion of the project-Area 1 and still wish to write some grants to cover the other proposed areas. The Board directed **Jim** to have Knife River submit a bid for this portion (Area 1) for this year, since there appeared to be no other qualified bidders. Our intention is to take this proposal to the Membership for authorization.

John had a progress report on the Glide History project he has initiated; the text has been scanned but not the photos and costs estimates for reproduction have not been submitted.
